- The Crown Jewel Trail is a VERY strenuous and challenging hike. Remember to bring extra water, snacks, first aid supplies, good boots, extra clothing layers and a communication device.
- We recommend bringing water shoes/sandals for the river crossing. (Pro tip: stash your wet gear in the bushes once you've crossed.)
- Watch for rain. The river can rise to dangerous levels after only 90 minutes of rain. If it's starts to rain heavily, **TURN AROUND!**
